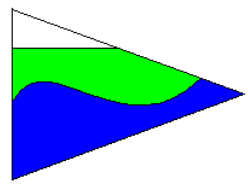

The Good Friday Lunch, as outlined in West Headings is proving popular. Please book with Genevieve early, to help planning.

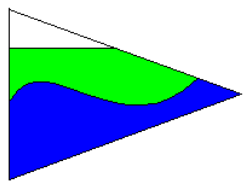
I look forward to some excellent sailing over Easter & catching up at the club.

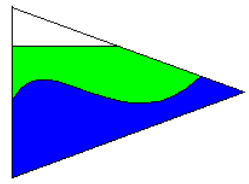

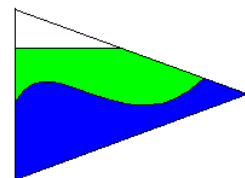

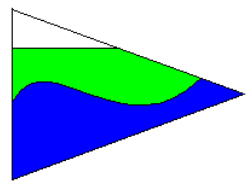

EASTER RABBIT STEW

- 140g prunes, about 8 – 10
- Grated orange peel
- 50ml brandy or more!
- 50g soft brown sugar
- 2 rabbits, jointed (do NOT collect carcasses from the Golf Course!!)
- plain flour, for dusting
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 3 – 4 rashers bacon, sliced into thin strips
- 2 carrots, chopped, 1 – 2 onions, chopped, 2 celery sticks, chopped
- 1 garlic clove, crushed, 2 thyme sprigs, 1 bay leaf
- 150ml red wine, the best you can afford and whatever is left over after you had had a glass or 2
- 150 - 250ml chicken stock (use as much as you feel you need for sloppy or less sloppy stew!
- chopped parsley and wild rice or mashed potatoes



Method

Heat oven to 150C/130C fan/gas 2. Put the prunes in a bowl with the brandy and brown sugar, stir, then set aside to soak.

Dust the rabbit in the flour. Heat the oil in a large flameproof dish and brown the rabbit all over until golden – you may have to do this in batches. Set the rabbit aside. Add the bacon, vegetables, garlic and herbs to the dish and fry for 5 mins until starting to colour.

Pour in the red wine and scrape all the goodness off the bottom of the dish. Add the chicken stock and put the rabbit back in the dish with the boozy prunes, then cover and cook for 2 hrs, stirring occasionally, until the rabbit is totally tender.

Serve scattered with parsley and wild rice or lovely mashed potato on the side.

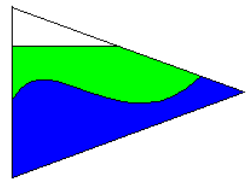

Do you think he will want winter storage in the FYC yard??

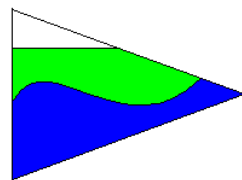

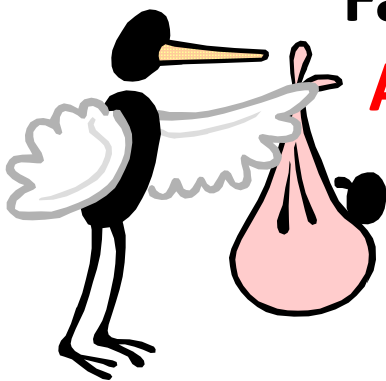

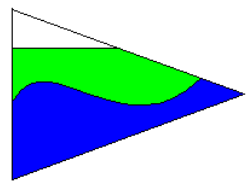
